ORDER OF COURT SCHEDULING RECOUNT/RECANVAS

AND NOW, to-wit, this 2nd day of December 2021, as a recount/recanvas petition has been filed for Leet Township District 1 and District 2, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED as follows:

1. The recount/recanvas of Leet Township Districts 1 and 2 shall be held on Wednesday, December 15, 2021, at 9:00 AM at the Allegheny County Elections Divisions Warehouse, 901 Pennsylvanian Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15233;
2. The recount/recanvas shall be conducted by the Allegheny County Elections Division and supervised by the Allegheny County Law Department;
3. The Allegheny County Elections Division shall appear before this Court in 707 City County Building on December 15, 2021, at 1:30 PM and report the results of the recount/recanvas;
4. Counsel for Petitioners shall provide prompt notice to all affected candidates for the office of Leet Township Commissioner. Those candidates being Rody Nash, Daniel M. Peluso, Mrs. Donna Adipierito, and Stephanie Turner;
5. Notice shall be given by hand delivery or certified mail and ordinary mail. Counsel for Petitioners shall promptly file a Certificate of Service forwarding a copy to this Court and to Allan J. Opsitnick, Assistant County Solicitor, 564 Forbes Avenue, Suite 1201, Pittsburgh, PA 15219, aopsitnick@opsitnickslaw.com;

6. Given space limitations and COVID concerns, each candidate or a single representative of said candidate may appear to view the recount/re canvass. Therefore, each candidate is permitted a single representative;

7. Masks shall be worn at all times during the recount/re canvass.
